Page 7: instructions

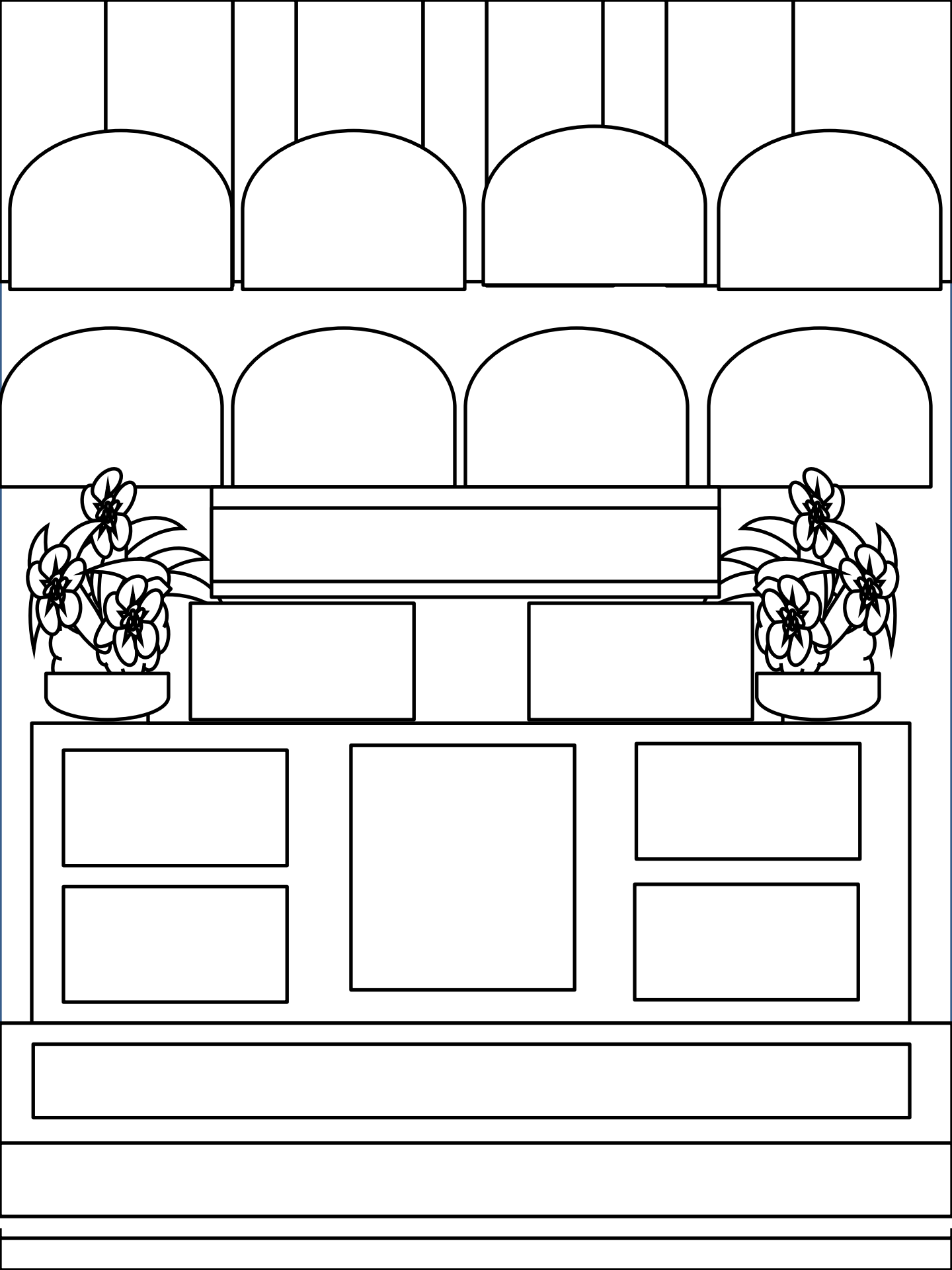
Page 8: Color your own background. Paste in words from page 4 or 5.

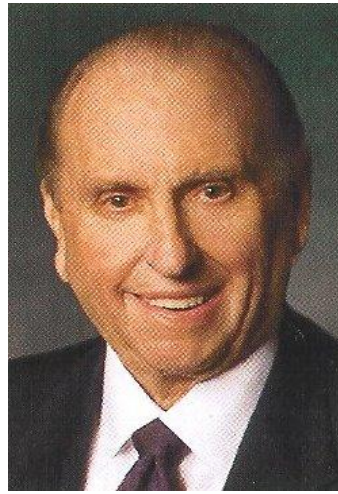
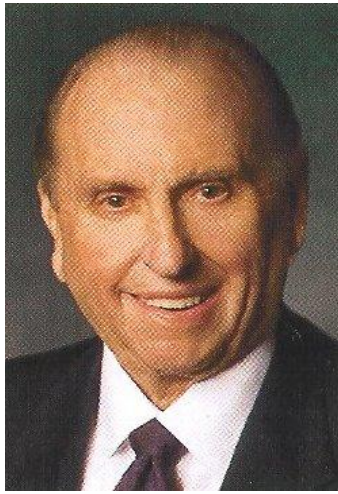
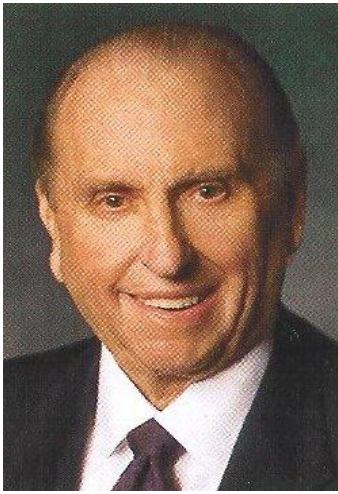
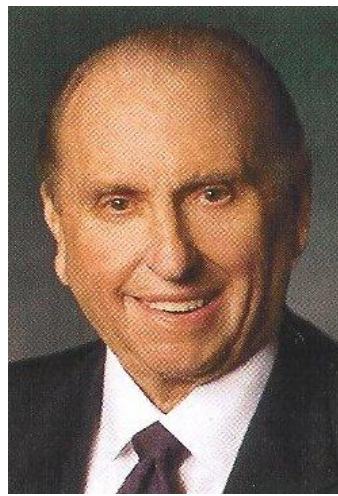
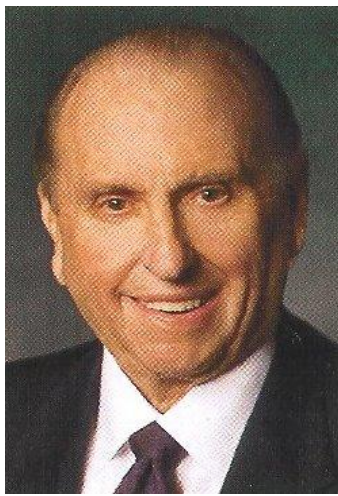
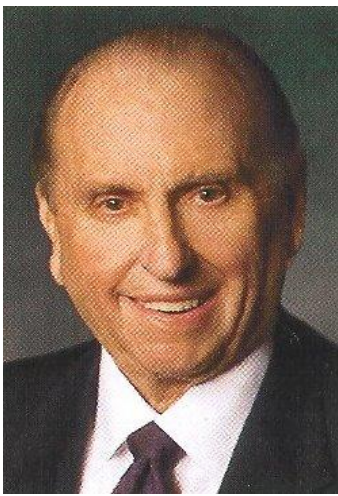
Page 9: Pictures of the prophet.
