


Colored ropes to cut out of you can draw on your own rope OR you can paste on a string, or yarn for the rope.





You can punch a small hole at the top of the mountain, and one at the bottom. Take a piece of yarn and thread it through the holes and tie a knot in the back of the paper. Then tape the person to the front toward the bottom, so the child can slide the person up and down the mountain. If you do this you **have** to use card stock for the paper. And for the person. If you want you can laminate the person.







Set of 5 each boy and girl






- Page 4 Colored Rock and cloud. Copy, cut, and paste on mountain.
- Page 5 Colored Rope. Copy and paste on mountain. OR use the string idea.
- Page 6 Colored people set of 5 girls and 5 boys. Copy, cut and paste on mountain.
- Page 7 Black and White Mountain with words. Copy, Color.
- Page 8 Black and White Mountain. Copy, then paste on words, rope, and person.
- Page 9 Black and white rock words and cloud. Copy, color and paste on mountain.
- Page 10 Black and white people. Copy, color and paste on mountain.
- Page 11 Black and white. Coloring page (girl). Add your own rope, by pasting a piece of yarn or string, or drawing it on.
- Page 12 Black and white. Coloring page (boy). Add your own rope, by pasting a piece of yarn or string, or drawing it on.
