Words are Words Game Instructions:

Copy off sheets 1 and 2. Copy off 2 sheets of page 7. Paste Words are Words on back of Names Copy off sheets 3 and 4. Copy off 2 sheets of page 8. Paste Words are Words on back of adjectives.

Cut out and laminate. Mix up Name cards and place in a pile with names facing down. Mix up adjectives and place in separate pile.

To Play:

Pass out 4 adjective cards for each player. Players may look at their cards, but not show anyone else. (Younger children may need help with the words) Youngest goes first.

Player picks from the Name card pile. Read the name, and then every player but the person who picked up the card puts down one adjective card that best describes that person on the name card. For example: Name card: Nephi. Players put down...courageous, nice, etc. Then that player (whose turn it is) picks the best word. The player who put down that card keeps the Name card. Each player that put down a card picks up 1 new adjective from the pile. Repeat the play. Once a player has gathered 4 name cards they have won the game.

Use the Book of Mormon for references:

If you come to a name that is unfamiliar, look in the index of the Book of Mormon and find something out about that name.

Make your own word and adjective cards using the black cards of page 10 and 11.
