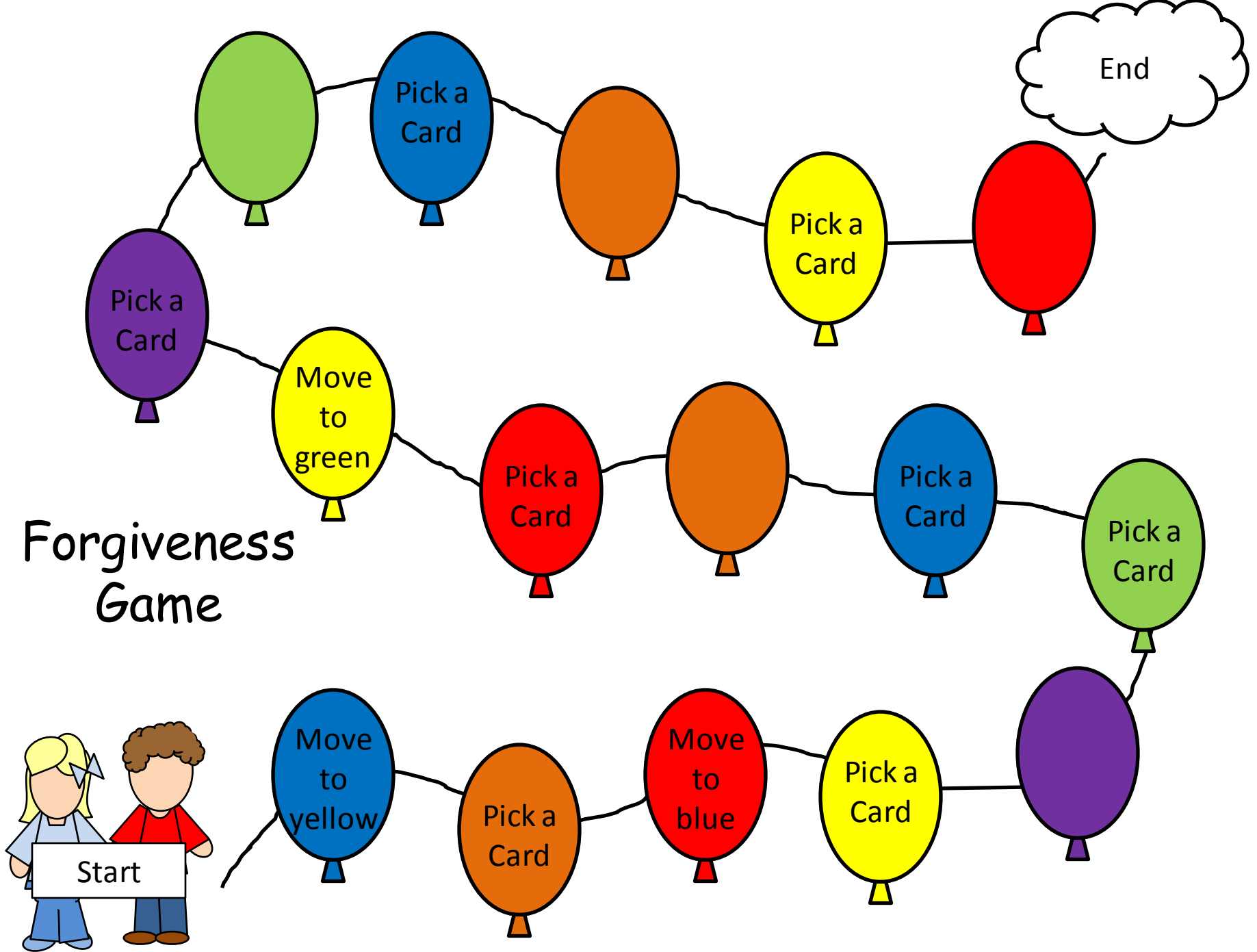


Forgiveness Game

Forgiveness Game Instructions:

Use buttons or other small objects for game piece. Use one die.

Youngest goes first. Roll dice. Move to balloon. Do as it says. When you land on "pick a card" pick a card and read and answer the question. Every answer is correct...just help them understand that they should forgive and forget.

Each player takes a turn until someone reaches the end.
