







Trying to Be An Example







Take a blank piece of paper Have them rub on the paper the backs of their shoes with crayon

Trace around child's shoe on the paper and cut it out and paste on construction paper.

If the child does not have a pattern on the back of their shoe use corrugated paper, or bring a tennis shoe.

## Luke 19:1-10 Story of Zacchaeus in the tree.

1 And *Jesus* entered and passed through Jericho.

2 And, behold, *there was* a man named Zacchæus, which was the chief among the publicans, and he was rich.3 And he sought to see Jesus who he was; and could not for the press, because he was little of stature.

4 And he ran before, and climbed up into a sycomore tree to see him: for he was to pass that *way*.

5 And when Jesus came to the place, he looked up, and saw him, and said unto him, Zacchæus, make haste, and come down; for to day I must abide at thy house.

6 And he made haste, and came down, and received him joyfully.

7 And when they saw *it*, they all murmured, saying, That he was gone to be guest with a man that is a sinner. 8 And Zacchæus stood, and said unto the Lord; Behold, Lord, the half of my goods I give to the poor; and if I have taken any thing from any man by false accusation, I restore *him* fourfold.

**9** And Jesus said unto him, This day is salvation come to this house, forsomuch as he also is a son of Abraham. **10** For the Son of man is come to seek and to <u>asave</u> that which was <u>blost</u>.
