What should you say?

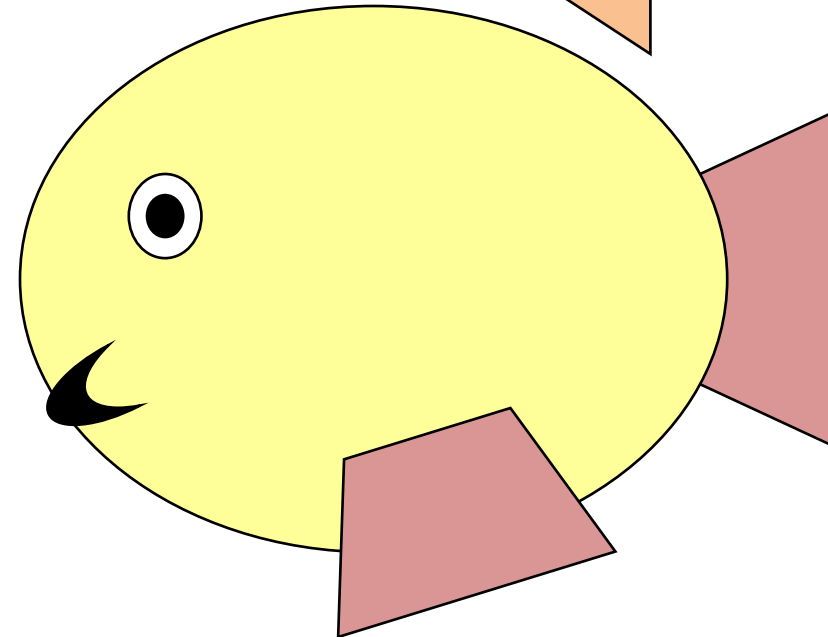
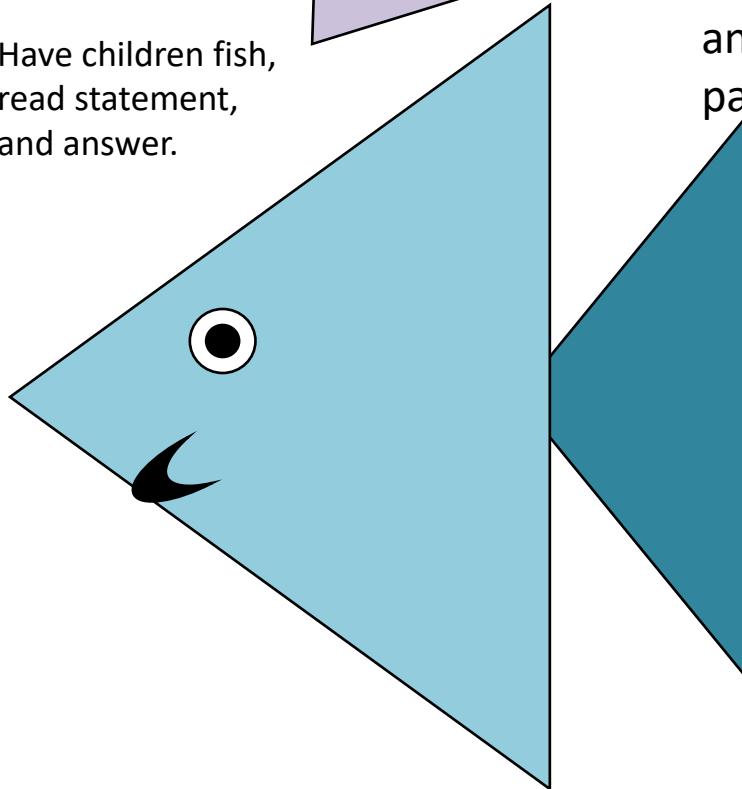

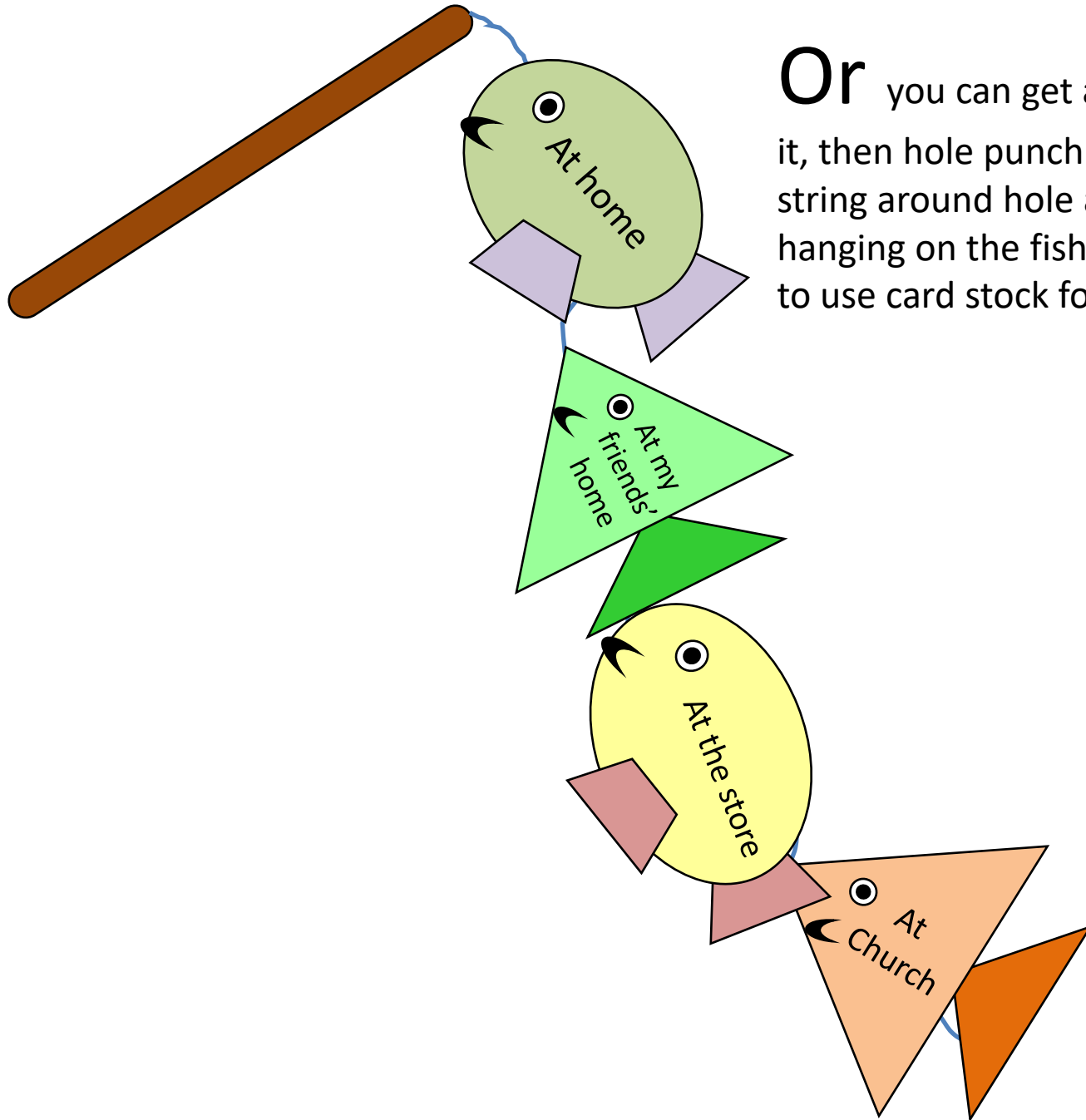


Copy on card stock
