You can find me: In your house or church. Or in your hands You can learn how to return to Heavenly Father. Learn about Jesus. You can read this.


You can do this: anytime, day or night. At home or anywhere. With a lot of people or by yourself. Kneeling or sitting. To receive help when you need it.


You can not see me. You can learn about me in the scriptures. You can trust in me and pray in my name. I died so everyone can live again. I have been resurrected.






For larger game on the board or the floor


You can cut out brown paper for stones for your game instead of copying them. Then use page 3 (keys) to put on stones.

Instructions for Treasure Map Game:

Page 2" Copy as many as you want). I find it easier for each child to have their own game board. Optional: Laminate

Use buttons for markers and place on start.

- 1. Youngest goes first. Roll one dice and move spaces.
- 2. If the player lands on a key stone pick from the key cards and read the back (Page 3 and 4)
- 3. Once a player has finished and landed on the treasure chest, pick a Gem (Page 5), and look at the picture and tell what the treasure is.

There are 8 gems, so try to finish game so each one has a turn at looking at the picture.

Instructions on Copying:

Page 2: Game Board

Page 3: Keys, copy off cut and paste page 4 statements on the back. Laminate if possible.

Page 4: copy, cut, and paste on back of keys.

Page 5: Copy gems and pictures. Paste picture on back of stone. Use at end of game.

Pages 6-8: Large game to put on the board or the floor
