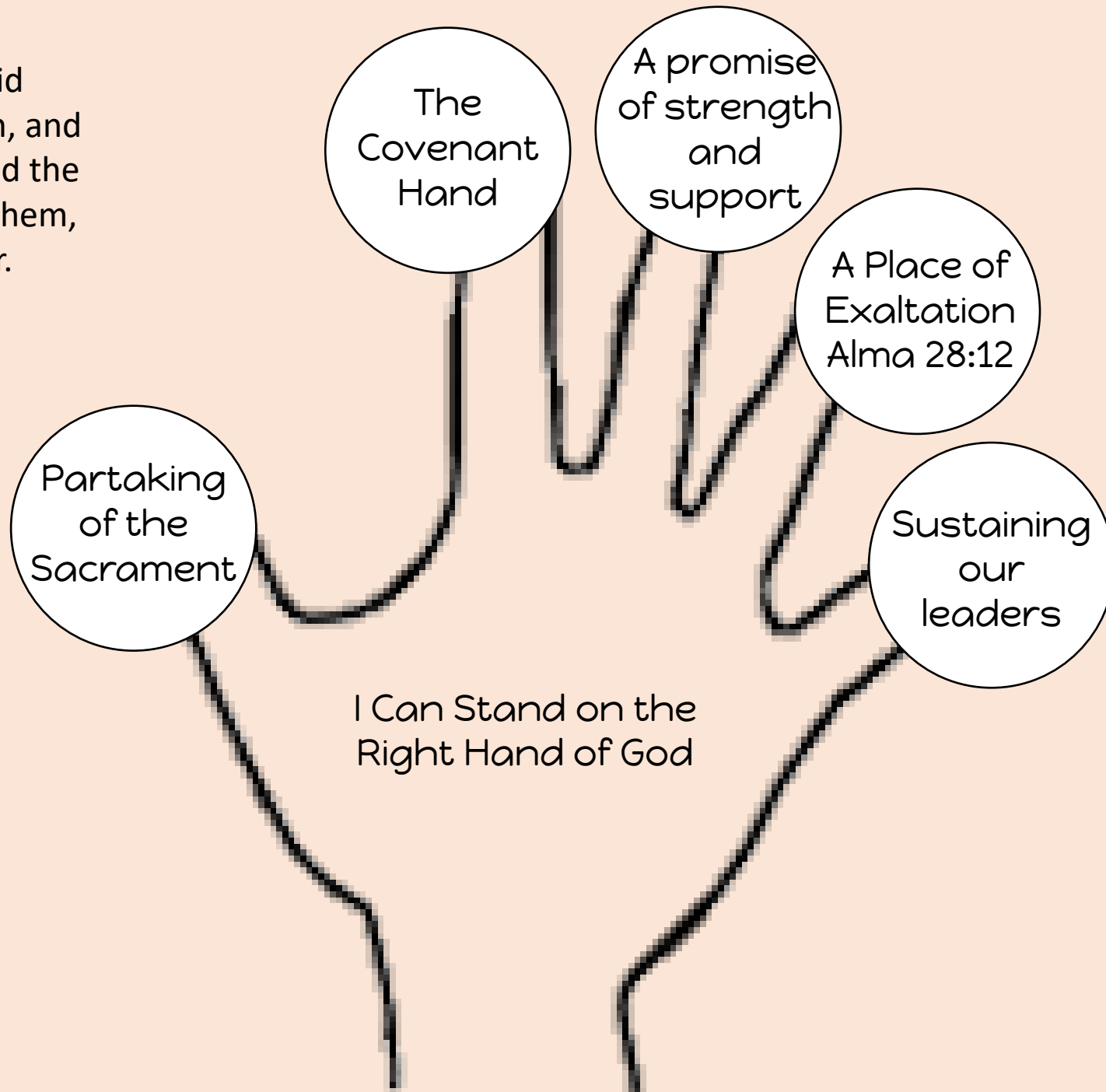

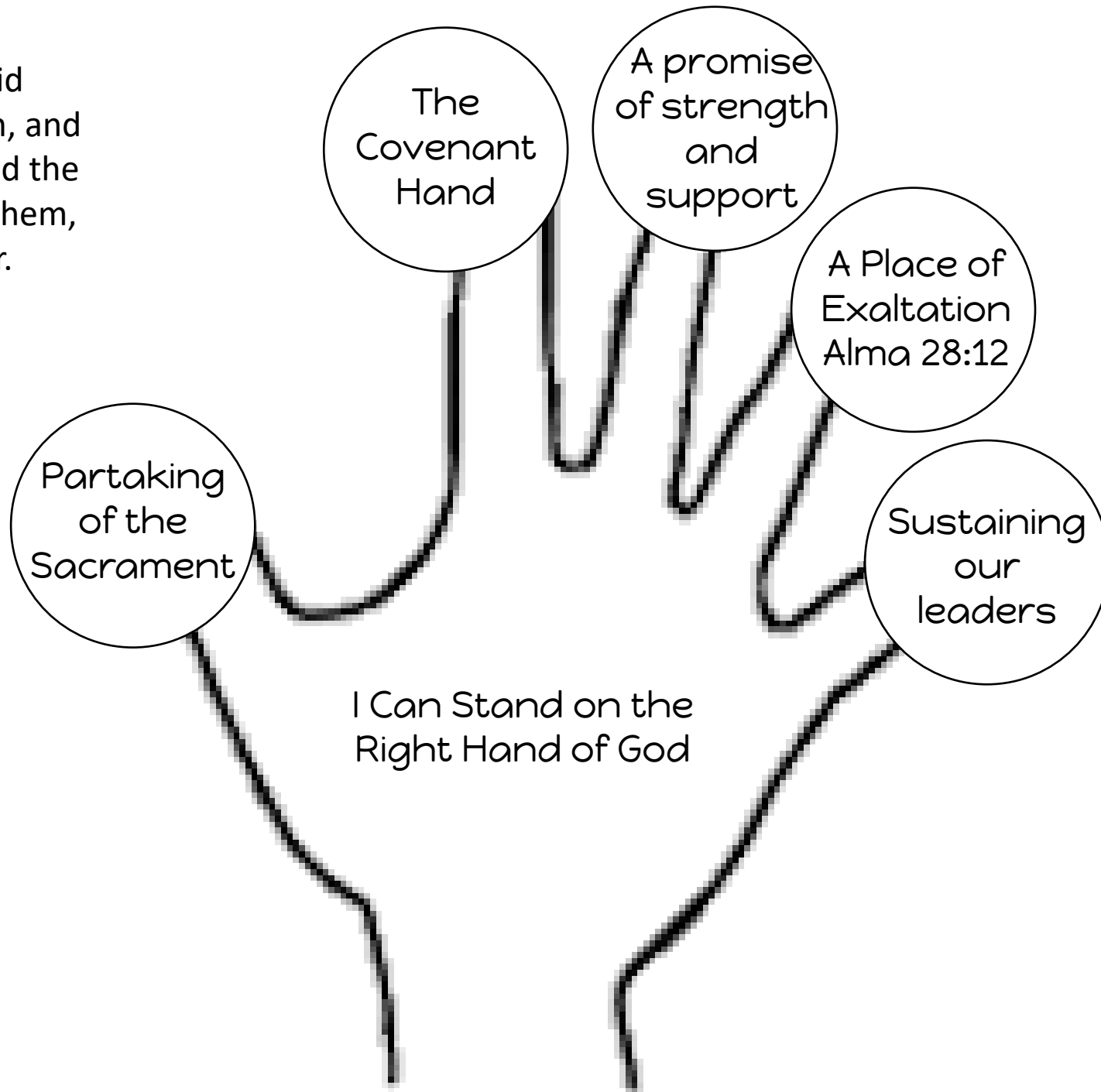

- Christ sits on *right hand* of the Father's power, Moro. 9:26.
- Christ sits on *right hand* of God, D&C 20:24 (76:20, 23).
- righteous shall be gathered on the Lord's *right hand*, D&C 29:27.

The use of the right hand as a symbolic gesture was in time extended to the administration of government oaths, and to the courtroom, as witnesses were called to testify under oath.

“It is the right hand of God—the covenant hand

Moses depicts the symbolic power of the Lord's right hand, declaring to his people that the law came from Sinai—fiery law (Det. 33:2)

Right hand = a place of exaltation (Alma 28:12)
